## **Work Study Job Description**

This is a part-time, 2-3 hour per day, (4-6:00 PM or 3-6:00 PM), Monday through Friday shift working with children ages 2 months to 5 years in the classrooms of our NAEYC accredited child care center. The teacher hired for this position will support lead teachers, providing for children's physical and emotional safety, provide help as needed with toileting and feeding, and keep relevant documents updated. Teachers will observe and document child learning through written notes and assessment tools. The employee will collaborate with lead teachers in planning and implementing age appropriate curriculum, encourage children's social and emotional development, and instill a sense of wonder and excitement about learning and creativity. Our teachers use positive guidance methods and strengthen each child's problem-solving and conflict resolution skills.

## **Minimum Qualifications**

- Must be able to pass a background check with the Department of Early Learning
- 18 years old and a high school graduate
- Must be in good physical health and able to lift up to 50 pounds
- Have proof of a negative TB test (Mantoux)
- Enjoy working on a team and be willing to learn new things
- Have good communication skills
