TITLE: Infant Lead Teacher - Full time w/benefits

Overview: This is a full-time position in our NAEYC accredited center. Our teachers provide experiential-based learning and collaborate in planning and implementing age-appropriate curriculum with children. Our infant teachers work with children 8 weeks – 18 months.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Encourage children's social and emotional development.
- Use positive guidance methods that strengthen each child's problem-solving and conflict resolution skills.
- Instill a sense of wonder and excitement about learning and creativity.
- Attend to children's physical and emotional safety using best practices.
- Be familiar with State Licensing requirements, as well as NAEYC Standards.
- Observe and document children's activities each day
- Plan developmentally appropriate activities within an emergent curriculum.
- Participate in self, classroom and center-wide evaluation processes.
- Develop collaborative relationships with families and staff.
- Maintain yearly required trainings and STARS credits.
- Use Teaching Strategies Gold to help shape curriculum

PREFERRED QUALIFICATIONS:

- Knowledgeable of basic computer and tablet use
 - ECE initial state certificate and extensive knowledge of early childhood

- AA or BA or equivalent in Early Childhood Education or Child Development

- Two or more years of experience working with children.
- Working knowledge of child development with appropriate age group.
- 18 years of age or older and a high school graduate.
- Enjoys working on a team.
- Excellent interpersonal communication skills with adults and children.

- Able to work required hours.
- Able to be aware of surroundings and care for children's safety.
- Willingness to use positive guidance methods.
